



Technicolor FCU Membership Code of Ethics

- Members will keep their account in good standing and abide by the rules and regulations as stated in the Truth and Savings Agreement and Loan Agreements.

- Members may not verbally or physically harass any member, staff, manager, or Board of Directors.

- Members are not to perform any physical acts, which may be portrayed in an offensive manner to any member, staff, manager, or Board of Directors.

- Members shall not de-face any credit union property.

- Members will not make any sexually explicit comments while in the presence of any member, staff, manager, or Board of Directors.

- Members will not make threats of or commit acts of violence toward any member, staff, manager, or Board of Directors.

Members who violate the Code of Ethics set forth above will be subject to review by the Board of Directors. The Board will have the authority to have the violating member's accounts limited, or in reoccurring or severe cases, the authority to close their accounts and membership in the Credit Union terminated.
